CEV Schools Project Information Guide & Application Form



Introduction:

The project is the brainchild of the CEV and includes the following.

- Equipment for Schools including 10 x Mikasa Soft Touch Volleyballs and net band
- Equipment for clubs including 10 X Training balls.
- VI led teacher & student training sessions weeks 1 & 3
- Official Volleyball Ireland partner school accreditation
- Teacher resources including lesson plans and coaching support
- Internal school blitz in line with Covid advice and restrictions
- Follow up VI <u>ALL STARS</u> programme launched with each club for students

For the 2020-21 season Volleyball Ireland is targeting the recruitment of 10 clubs that will each establish links with between 2 local feeder schools including either primary or post primary schools (age targets 9-13 years old).

How it works:

- 1. Clubs apply to join the programme through the application form below, identifying a CEV Schools Project lead. Clubs will also identify potential coaches to work on the programme.
- 2. The Club and Project Lead will work with a VI staff member to recruit 2 schools located in close proximity to the club. The main target age is 9-13yrs.
- 3. Volleyball Ireland visit the school and provide two skills session for pupils within the target age range. Participating teachers will be observing and supplied with resources in line with our new LTPD.
- 4. 10 soft touch Mikasa training balls are provided to each participating school and club.
- 5. Each school runs a 5-week Volleyball programme (ideally supported by the Club Coach). At the end of the 5-week activity, each school participates in a fun internal blitz.
- 6. At the completion of the schools programme the local club will initiate the next stage- The <u>ALL STARS</u> Project. This is designed for the students to continue their development in a club setting. Club coaches will be provided with resources for a 6-week programme to retain the new junior members.
- 7. Throughout the programme the club and school should work together to setup a link and encourage the students to club nights into the future.

8. The six-week club programme is subsided by VI and each student will receive a T-Shirt with club name and training ball when they sign up through VI for the full 6 weeks at a €30 fee. (clubs will be provided with a subsidy of €22 per child from Volleyball Ireland to help cover hall costs during the All Stars programme. Upon completion the club will arrange with the players /parents their own club fees and policies moving forward.

Please note; any club that wishes to participate in the CEV Schools Project must have clear evidence that all coaches involved in the youth section are Garda Vetted, and that the club has a Designated Liaison Person and Children's Officer appointed. If successful in their application, all clubs must provide a copy of their Child Safety Statement and Risk Assessment (as per Children's First Act, 2015).

Timelines:

Due to Covid 19 restrictions we will be working with each club remotely in 2020 to identify feeder schools only. The project will launch in hopefully early 2021 once restrictions are lifted to a suitable level and sport in schools is allowed once again.
