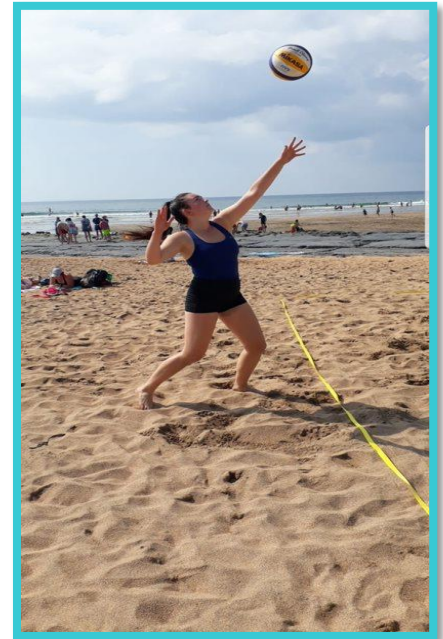

7. On site amenities

Garrylucas Beach

Public parking and toilets are provided adjacent to the beach and lifeguards are on duty during the summer season. Access to the beach by ramps and steps.

Bettystown Beach

The courts will be located on the beach next to Bettystown beside the lifeguard station. Parents can find coffee shops, bathrooms, and extra facilities all within 1km. Cars are not allowed to park on the beach but there is some small parking outside bistro BT

Dangan Sports Ground

NUIG's Dangan Sports Ground is located in the heart of Galway city. There are toilet facilities on site and several shops that can be easily accessed by a short drive. Parking is free.
