This event is FREE of Charge however all referees must register your names via the JUSTGO link on the final page





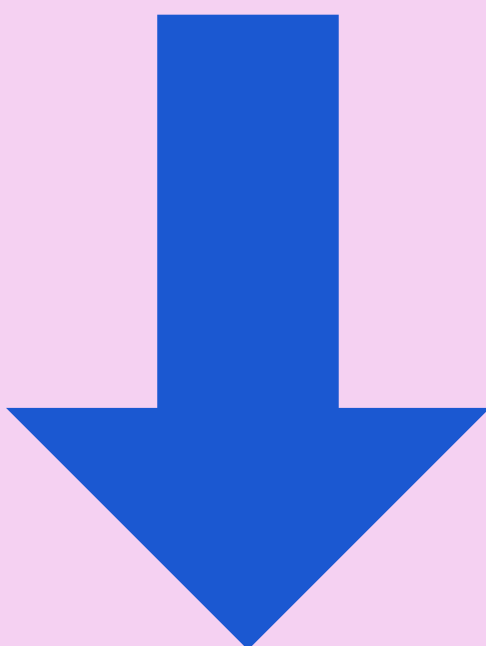
